**Eyjafjallajökull** erupted in 2010 in Iceland

**Krakatoa** erupted in 1883 and is said to be the loudest sound ever heard in modern history

**Mount Ararat** is a snow-capped dormant volcano said to be the resting spot of Noah's arc

**Mount Etna** is the tallest active volcano on the European continent, said to be where the mythological monster Typhon was trapped by Zeus

**Mount Fuji** is an active stratovolcano in Japan

**Mauna Kea** is the tallest (Dormant) Volcano in the world

**Mount Kilimanjaro** has three volcanic cones and is the highest free-standing mountain in the world

**Mount St. Helens** erupted in 1980 in the United States
