| Eyjafjallajökull | - The tallest active volcano on the European continent, said to be where the mythological monster Typhon was trapped by Zeus |
| Krakatoa | - Is the tallest (Dormant) Volcano in the world |
| Mount Ararat | - The tallest (Active) volcano in the world |
| Mount Etna | - Erupted in 1980 in the United States |
| Mount Fuji | - A supervolcano and the largest volcanic lake |
| Mauna Kea | - Erupted in 1883 and is said to be the loudest sound ever heard in modern history |
| Mount Kilimanjaro | - Erupted in 2010 in Iceland |
| Mount St. Helens | - Erupted in AD 79 and destroyed the Roman city of Pompeii |
| Mount Tambora | - It's 1815 eruption was the largest volcanic eruption in recorded history |
| Mount Rainer | - Has three volcanic cones and is the highest free-standing mountain in the world. |
| Mount Vesuvius | - An active stratovolcano in Japan |
| Ojos del Salado | - A snow-capped dormant volcano said to be the resting spot of Noah's arc |
| Toba | - Is considered one of the most dangerous volcanoes in the world and contains glacier ice |
